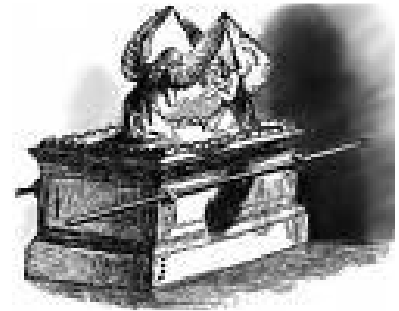

## Exodus 31:18 – 33:23

Exodus chapters 25 through 31 records the instructions God gave Moses while he was on the mountain. Chapter 32 begins where chapter 24 ends. Consider Exodus 24:7-18 as you work on the questions below.

What did the people promise before Moses went up to the mountain?

How long was Moses on the mountain with God?

What did the people want Aaron to do? Why?

For what two reasons did Moses ask God to preserve the people?

What did God tell Moses to do with the people the day after the calf was destroyed?
